- \* 43 National Units based in 40 Erasmus plus program countries (27 member states + Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Moldova, Montenegro, Norway, Republic of North Macedonia, Serbia, Switzerland, Türkiye and Ukraine)
- \* Montenegro member of the Eurydice Network since 2013.
- The Montenegrin National Unit operates within the Ministry of Education, Science and Innovation



Funding in education Educational policy is created at the central level. The Ministry of Education, Science and Innovation is responsible for the overall educational policy. > 4. When it comes to the financing of public institutions of higher education, the mutual rights and obligations between the public institution and the Government for the implementation of study programs of the I and II > 6. Quality assurance resource centres, by adult education providers, universities, faculties, academy of art and upper secondary non tertiary schools, all of which can be public or private. > 12. Mobility and internationalisation At up to the university public educational institutions, education is of secular character and the religious activity is not allowed except in the secondary religious schools. > 14. Ongoing reforms and policy developments Equity: Montenegrin citizens are equal in their rights to education, irrespective of nationality, race, sex, language, religion, 15. Legislation and official policy documents social background or other personal ability. Foreign citizens who have short-term residence or permanently reside in Montenegro, are equal in their rights to education with Montenegrin citizens. With regards to higher education, a foreigner 16. Glossary

is entitled to be enrolled in study programmes in Montenegro under the same conditions as Montenegrin citizens, in

compliance with the Law on Higher Education and statute of the institution.
